

## How to Self-Educate Webinar

**Course Description:** This course focuses on how to learn independently and to teach students self-education. We will identify different types of books, what to look for, how to interact with a book, and various ways to narrate for optimal learning.

**Course design:** The course will have three live meetings on Zoom for discussion. Class participation via discussion boards, assignments, and the schedule will all be accessed through the free Canvas platform throughout the course. Each student will need an email account to register. You can register using a parent's email account, but the student will need it to access the course. If registering with more than two children, there will need to be two email accounts, one for each student.

**Course expectations**: Students are expected to do the assignments and practice what is discussed in the webinar. Outside assignments can be tailored to the specific student's courses, so time needed outside of class will be minimal. If a class is missed, each student is required to watch the recording before coming to class. This course is critical for in-person participation for each student to get the most out of the class.

## **Supplies needed:**

- Canvas account (Information sent out- free.)
- Printable documents (provided by CW).
- A notebook for notes and assignments.
- Two school books to work through ideas (recommend one fiction and one non-fiction).
- Optional but recommended:
  - Sticky notes
  - Different color pens/highlighters

**Pre-requisites:** Grades 7 and up and/or developmentally ready to begin working independently.
